



16-19 Tuition Fund Statement 2021-2022

In order to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from coronavirus (COVID-19) for disadvantaged TRC students, we are using the 16-19 tuition fund to provide one-to-one and small group tuition.

All students who did not achieve a GCSE grade 4 in Maths and/or English Maths are undertaking small group tuition. Any grade 4 student who is also resitting GCSE English or Maths in the hope of improving to at least a 5 is also included. In order to ensure positive relationships underpin small group tuition from the first session, the student's subject teacher is, in most cases, also their Tutor. This decision was also taken in order to maximise the effectiveness of feedback from tutoring sessions as well as to allow tutor groupings to change responsively within a class where relevant.

In addition, students with a Special Educational Need and those from an economically disadvantaged background who are in need of additional support are accessing one-to-one / small group tuition to enable them to reach their potential in their Level 3 studies.

All tuition is being delivered in person, unless individual circumstances or closure necessitate a switch to remote learning. Sessions are part of planned learning hours in the daily timetable. Attendance is registered as part of the student's study programme and is subject to the code outlined in the Learner Expectation Agreements and attendance disciplinary process.
